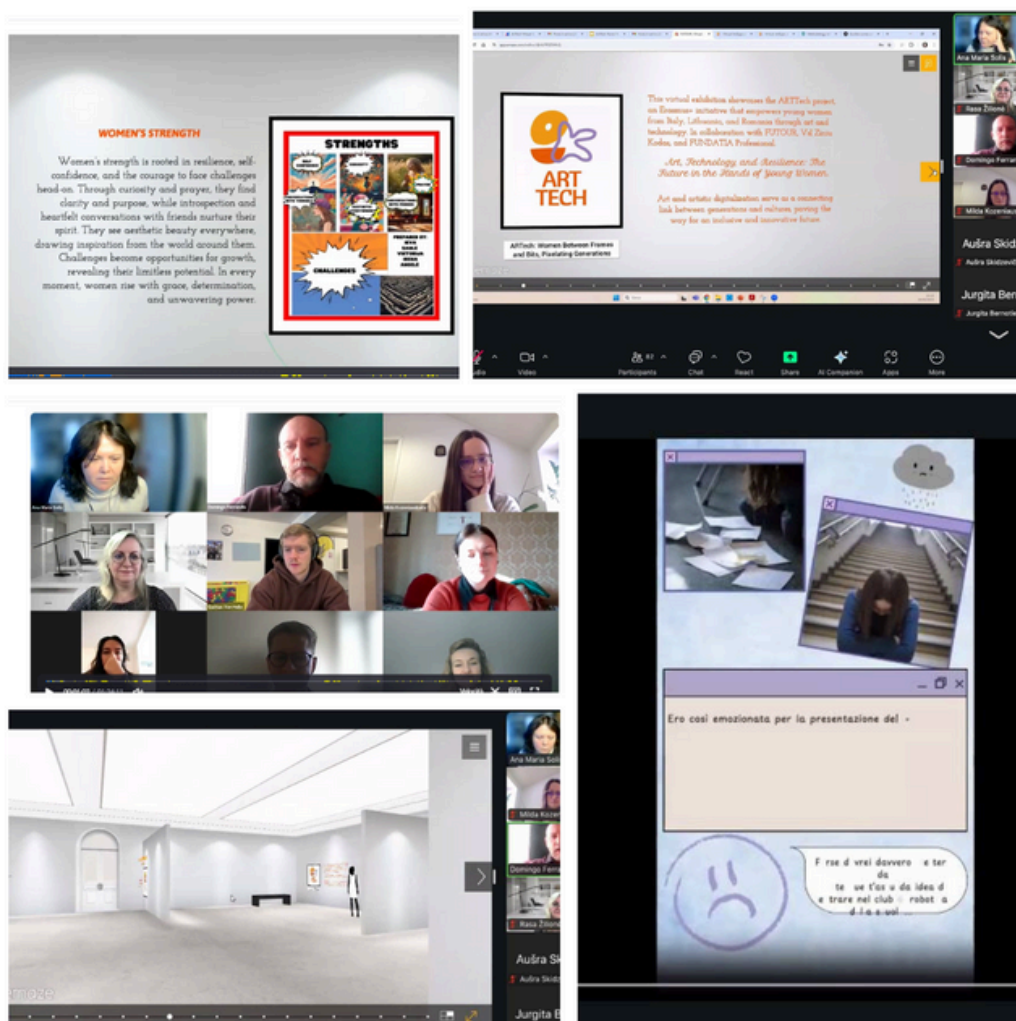
Objectives

- To create an empowered community focused on bridging gender gaps and advancing gender equality.

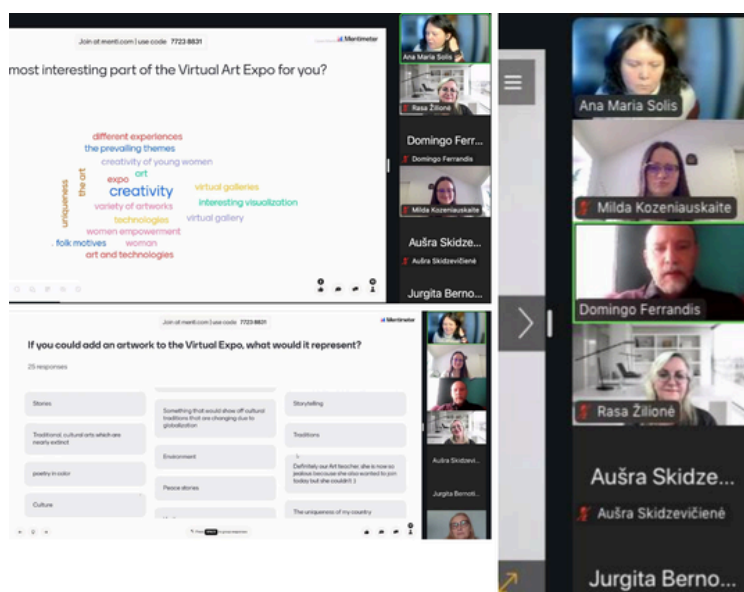


VIRTUAL ART EXPO: AN INTERNATIONAL DIGITAL ART GATHERING

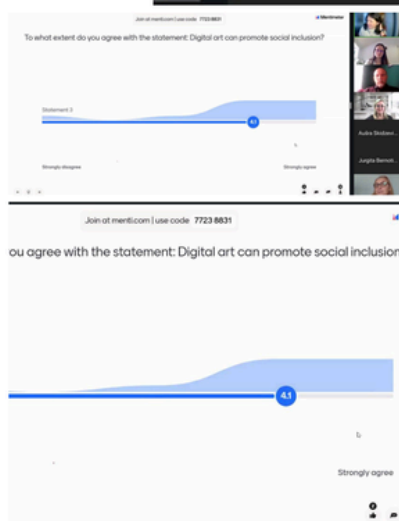
VIRTUAL ART EXPO: AN INTERNATIONAL DIGITAL ART GATHERING

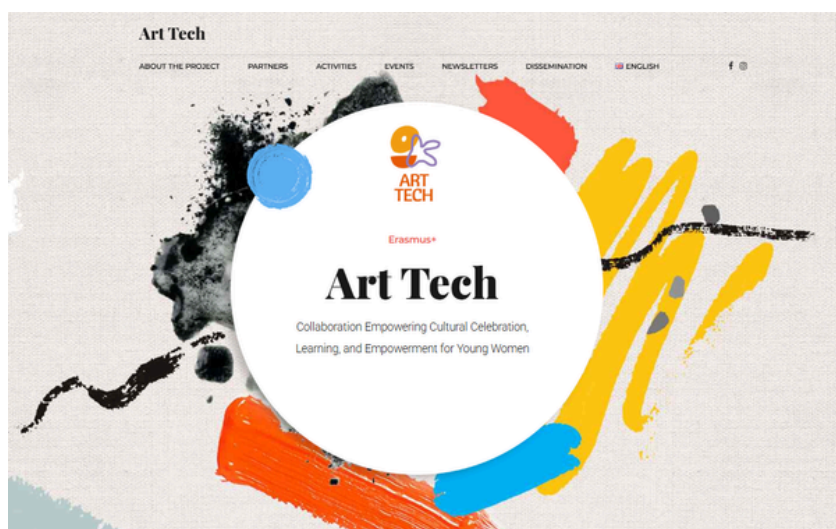
